What will we be doing?

Client Registration

Prayer Ministry, Spiritual / special program

Fresh produce distribution

Event Schedule:

8 – 9 am- Houston Food Bank delivers produce (fruit and vegetable in sacks or boxes)

9 am- Volunteers set up parking area, registration area, fellowship hall and food distribution area
Volunteers sort produce to around 100-200 portions

9:30 am- Client registration starts, prayer station opens

10:30-11 am- Spiritual/ special program

11 am- 11:30 am Clients pull their car and line up to pick up produce.

11:30am- 12noon Clean up

Volunteer Duties:

Sort food (require standing, bending, light lifting, some heavy lifting for strong guys)

Traffic control

Load food to clients' cars

Volunteer Group Sign up:

Each event needs at least 40 volunteers from different fellowship groups

Fellowship or zone based (Big Group) sign up is highly encouraged
